


Reconstituting the MCP1 standard in 2 mL of assay diluent results in a concentration of 5,000 pg/mL. Standard curves for no-wash and 1-wash protocols are shown starting from 5,000 pg/mL and proceeding in a 1:2 serial titration. The limit of detection, represented by the dashed line, is determined by adding 3 standard deviations to the mean of samples without MCP1 (N=12). Results are typical and may vary based on specific assay conditions.
